

## **Year 6 Standard Assessment Tests for 2019**

The 'Expected' standardised score is 100. Scores for pupils range from 80 to 120.

The results below show that we were extremely similar to the Lancashire average for our average standardised point scores. Scores likely to rise slightly once successful papers sent back for re-marking are included.

## **SATs for Writing in 2019**

Writing is graded using detailed criteria set out by the Department for Education and is not presented as a mark. The percentage of children who achieved the 'Expected' standard in 2019 was **82%** compared to the Lancashire average of 78%.

## **Children with Special Educational Needs**

Children with special educational needs are included within the Year 6 SATs results. Some of these children performed better than would have been predicted when they were in Year 2. A few did struggle though on the length and abstract nature of the reading paper.

## **Most Able Pupils**

Our many able pupils performed very well and many gained marks of 117,118 or 120 (remember 120 is the highest possible mark).

Raising Standards Even Further for Y6 SATs – 'The Future'

Our aim is to lift school results well above the Lancashire averages in the future. Many measures have already been put in place and the impact of these should be reflected in the coming years. Examples have included:

- Effective interventions for both maths and English for every year group & all abilities
- Maximising time in the school day – slick systems (including movement around school)
- Having a tight and robust link between assessment, feedback and planning
- Increasing the quality of play and having so many extra-curricular activities (yes this helps raise standards too!)

### **Year 2 SATs**

In a similar way to the writing for the Y6 SATs, the Y2 results are presented as a percentage of children attaining the 'Expected' standard.
