## QUICK REMINDERS

- Please can parents label ALL items of children’s uniform as this means we can return lost items to their owners.

- On the new trim trail, one important rule we enforce is no hanging or spinning upside down on the ropes. If you're supervising your child on the trim trail, please help reinforce this rule.
- Children should not be wearing earrings on days that they have swimming or PE. If they do, they have to be removed for activities and can easily be lost.
