Swimming Days - Pool is running happily with it's new big sand filter, so school lessons are back on.

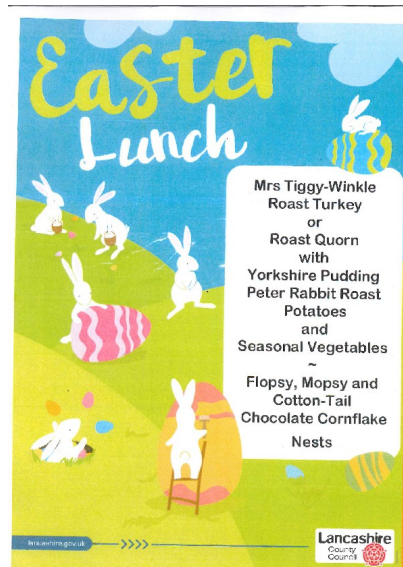
