## HEADTEACHER UPDATES

It has been a busy week in school with the **Y1 phonics screening, Y4 multiplication tests** and other assessments. Y5 created and delivered their own games and tasks for our reception classes whilst the children due to start in September had some taster afternoons. **Well done to 2B** who ended the week with an entertaining shortened version of the tale *Wind in the Willows*.

Next week starts with a **Y3 trip to Martin Mere** where their staff give excellent practical ecological workshops. On Tuesday bike ability starts for Y4 and on Thursday Y3 have special scooter lessons. Just to add to the busyness of the week there will be the opportunity for Junior aged children to join in the **triathlon** on Thursday and Friday as the go-karts will be here. Y3, 4 & 5 will have their chance to do this on the Thursday in place of their swimming lesson. Y6 children who want to do the triathlon will be doing it during the last lesson on the Friday. All triathletes will need their swimming kits, a T-shirt and trainers and a towel. Those not joining in will be the marshals around the course. All of 3S should start the day as usual at the pool not the Hub, even if not choosing to do the triathlon.

The **Y4 Camp Night** will also be on this Thursday after postponing last week due to the weather forecast of thunderstorms.

On Friday it is a **non-uniform day for all children who bring in a bottle** (from wine to shampoo!). All the bottles are then stored ready for the summer fayre bottle tombola.

On Friday 27<sup>th</sup> June we are holding **Sports Day**. Do bring your own camping chair as we only put out a dozen chairs per year group. Children arrive from 1pm on the big field but we only officially start at 1.15pm and aim to all be finished by 3.30pm. Collection is direct from the big field. At 3.30pm parents collect their youngest children first, direct from their teachers on the big field. Any children attending the after school club we keep with any late pick ups by the big tree.

The **Summer Fayre** is straight after Sports Day and is held on the field adjacent to the main drive. There will be the bouncy castles, tombolas etc. If you would like to have a stall to sell your own produce (cakes, plants etc), or are able to help out at all please let us know by messaging Gateway. Any money raised will go towards doing up the infant trim trail.



\* Taekwondo is paid for a session at a time. Just send your child in with £5 each week. This is held in the gym.


