## HEADTEACHER UPDATES

The Year 6 children who went to London were fantastic and so cheerful despite temperatures of 34 degrees and a number of 'transport challenges'. Our residential included museum tours, an open top bus tour and a trip up the Thames in a large speedy ferry with a welcome breeze cooling us down. We



also found time to watch The Lion King, do a workshop on the Hinde ship, take a cable car over the Thames from the O2 and eat a number of healthy oranges (and also gobble down a lot of ice creams!). Finally, we spent an afternoon at the Harry Potter World in Watford before returning to Ormskirk. Photos will no doubt feature in the latest Sway edition later.

Year 5 will be preparing for their residential to York in the week beginning 14th July. Meanwhile, Y3 are heading off to Chester this Tuesday. Y2 will be studying the seaside town of Southport and then visiting Ainsdale in approximately a week. Amongst other things we will be looking will be the movement of sand and growth of grass on the beaches. I will let Y2 parents know when this trip will take place. For trips we often need parent or grandparent volunteers, however it is ideal if the parent does not have a child in the class who are going on the trip (this is due to a technical twist in risk assessment numbers). If you or a grandparent would be interested in assisting on future trips then please let the office know so we can put together a pool of people to ask as we approach trips (also we can apply for DBS checks for these parents / grandparents in advance).

We have had a number of staff absent for one reason or another in the last few weeks. Fortunately, we have a two teachers in every year group so if one teacher is absent the other teacher can lead and keep the curriculum on track whilst we fill in the absent teacher with an additional member of our school team, or on occasion a supply teacher. I am very grateful to all of our staff for doing this and being so flexible.

I will be emailing out a short 'Headteacher Letter to Parents' shortly. It shows which class has which teacher in September. This coming Thursday morning the children will have a 'moving up' lesson with their September teacher. The HT letter mentions a middle management structure which will be starting in September. Every two year groups will have what we will call a Phase Lead. As well as other roles, these members of staff will be the person to go to after your child's class teacher. The phase leads will also be keeping an eye on parity & consistency between classes and double-checking children are making good progress as they move up into the next year groups.

Finally, it is with relief that I can confirm that the sink hole in the centre of Ormskirk is repaired and the roadworks are no longer causing a traffic jam. ©
