There is a Library Goodie Bag for our top five entries.

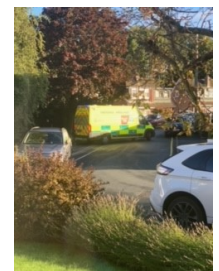
You have until the end of Thursday 6th October to hand in your poems to your teacher.
