Due to a number of reasons, we are having to split parents' evenings over a few weeks (see left).

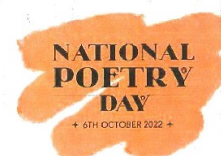
All classes and year groups apart from Reception, Year 5 and 3S are on the 4th and 6th October.
