Clothes being named is helpful too!

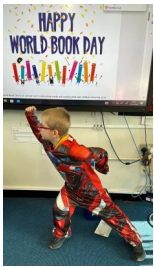

Measles

There have been several outbreaks of measles across Lancashire recently so it is important to make sure your child's vaccinations are up to date. If you are unsure, contact your GP. The main symptom of measles is a red-brown blotchy rash. Your child may have cold-like symptoms for a few days before the rash appears. In some the illness can be serious. Measles is spread through coughs and sneezes. A person is most contagious from when symptoms develop until about 4 days after the rash first appears.
