All children need a swimming cap. These can be bought for £5 from the school offices.



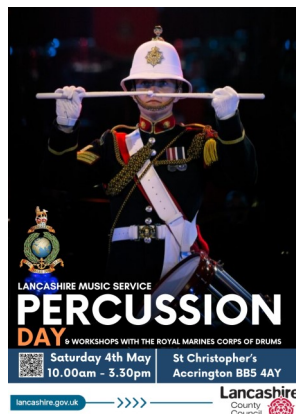
Please try and pay any outstanding balances you may have through the

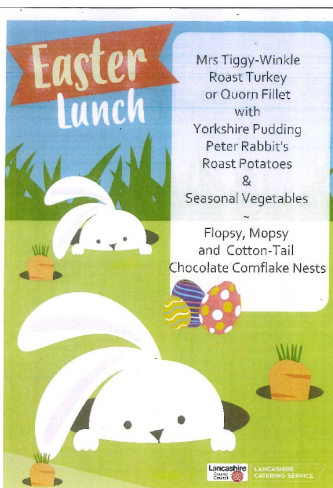
