HEADTEACHER UPDATE

Success, Sports Day and Summer Fayre!

Congratulations to another school team making it through to the County Finals, which take place later this term. This time it was our **netball team** who triumphed in the district finals. Mr Peetoom shared that the play-offs couldn't have gone any better,



describing the competition as extremely challenging against other tournament winners. He praised the team's outstanding performance, noting that in all his years of school sport, he hasn't seen better teamwork. He was incredibly proud of their effort, commitment, and the high level at which they are playing.

Our **Sports Day** is this Friday afternoon (19th June, starting at 1.15pm) on the big field. It will be a similar set up to last year and we will use helium balloons to help guide parents on where their children will be. It would be good if children had caps with names in and a bottle of water. Also, it would be good if they had sun cream on. The weather forecast is good - not too hot and it is unlikely it is going to rain. At the end of Sports Day please collect your youngest child first and together then collect your older child, etc. On Friday children come to school in their PE kits, ideally wearing their team coloured shirt.

Straight after Sports Day is the **Summer Fayre** which is located on the front field. Great attendance has made this a very special event over the years and we are hopeful that this year will be no exception. There will be a silent disco, donkey rides, bouncy slide / castles, cakes, refreshments, a toy stall, a book stall (& bookmark making), ice cream van, football shoot out, raffle, bottle tombola, etc. For the fayre we will doing transactions in cash, so please bring coins.
