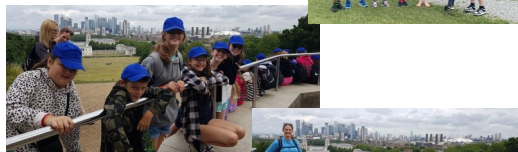
Year 6 Leavers' Service

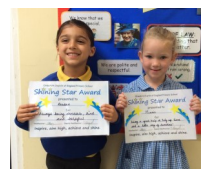


Year 6 looking out over London.
