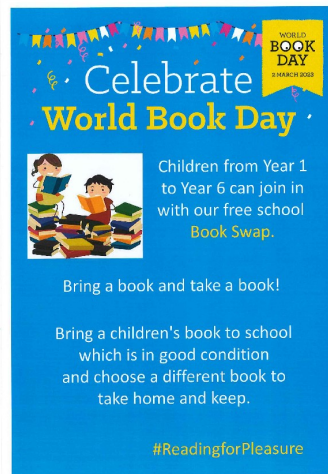
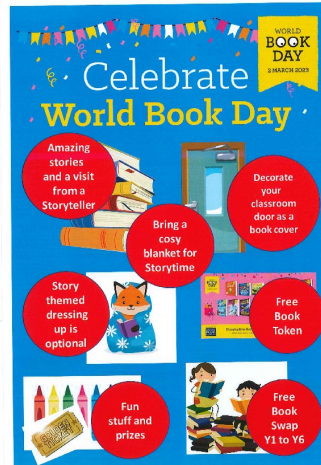
World Book Day

Menu on the 21st February will be the same as on Gateway but there will be pancakes for pudding.

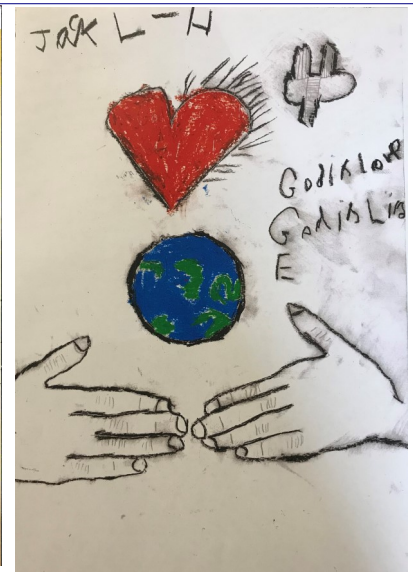
