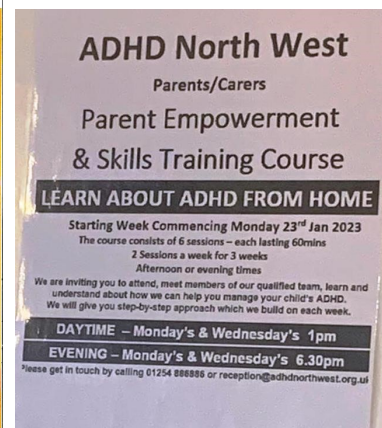
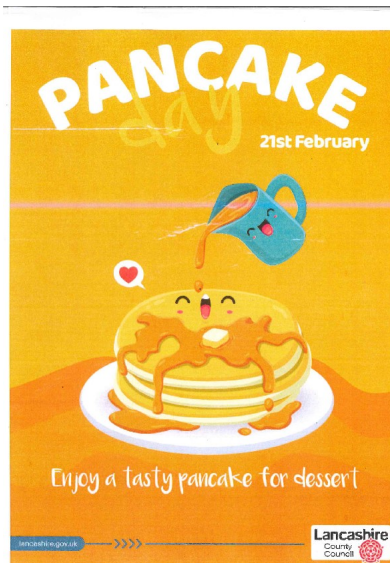
Children should not be arriving before 8:35am unless an adult stays with them. Any parent needing to drop off before this time, please book your child into Breakfast Club.
